

# WINE

## White Wines

Waters Edge, Sauvignon Blanc – Chile 5.95 / 7.75 / 22  
*A light, fresh and crisp dry white with hints of citrus and gooseberry.*

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Belle Modella, Pinot Grigio – Italy 6.25 / 8 / 23  
*A beautifully, light, vibrant white to be appreciated for its zesty, citrus and green apple character and refreshing quality.*

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Land of Plenty Sauvignon Blanc – New Zealand 8.5 / 11 / 30  
*New Zealand continues to wow our taste buds with terrific tasting Marlborough Sauvignon Blancs. This new to our list white certainly bears this out, with its 12.5% elegance and zesty citrus, Granny Smith apple, green pepper, and mineral notes.*

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McPhersons Chardonnay – Australia 8.75 / 11.5 / 32  
*A delightful, fruit-driven wine displaying aromas of tropical fruits and peaches with just a hint of lightly toasted oak.*

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Les Chiens, Catalans Blanc – France 26  
*Slightly floral on the nose with a hint of minerality and pastry. Honeysuckle, peaches and herbs shine through from the Rousanne supported by lovely texture, depth and weight from the Grenache Blanc. A salivating mouth, which is slightly saline and with juicy pear notes.*

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Aguazul, Verdejo Rueda – Spain 28  
*Aguazul Verdejo Organic Rueda is a beautifully balanced and easy drinking Verdejo, with ripe lemon and delicate tropical fruit on both the nose and the palate. Harmonious, refreshing with a herbal twist of fennel on the finish.*

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Domaine de la Motte, Chablis – France 48  
*From a warmer vintage, this has full, ripe fruit yet still retains a proper mineral backbone with added depth from a small (around 10%) addition of oak-aged wine into the blend. Very typical of the Motte style, this gives richness and balance to the wine. A delicious, generous expression of classic chalky Chablis terroir.*

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## Rosé

Waters Edge, Zinfandel – USA 6.5 / 8.5 / 24  
*With delicious soft fruit flavours of strawberries, raspberries and melon.*

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Pasquiers Rosé – France 7.25 / 8.75 / 25  
*This luscious and textural blend is very much a food wine; tangy red berries flavours provided by Grenache meld with spice from Cinsault before the dry and fresh finish.*

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Palm Par L'escarelle – Provence, France 38  
*The ambassador of the range, this is a radiant, pale-pink appearance, a delicate, subtle nose and is fresh and lively on the palate. The fruity aromas of this easy-drinking wine make it perfect for an aperitif or enjoyed with tapas, a tasty pizza or a little charcuterie.*

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# WINE

## Red Wines

Waters Edge, Shiraz – Australia

6 / 7.75 / 22

*A soft rounded easy drinking red with well balanced fruit flavours and a light spicy finish.*

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Calusari Pinot Noir – Romania

6.5 / 8.5 / 24

*Gorgeous dark fruit flavours, almost syrupy in its concentration. Dark, rich and potent, with layers of black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Deep, with pretty fruit cake and spicy aromatics. A lovely long finish.*

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Los Espinos Merlot – Chile

7 / 9 / 26

*This is simply outstanding wine for the money, soft super-juicy ripe plummy fruit and a long full-flavoured finish. This easy-drinking wine comes from Chile's renowned Valle Central region, where long hot days are followed by cool nights. This temperature difference ensures the grapes ripen slowly, so they develop maximum flavour.*

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Despicito Malbec – Argentina

7.25 / 9.25 / 27

*It presents a bright red colour with fresh aromas of plums and blackberries and a hint of spice. The palate is clean and smooth with enticing red and black berry fruit, perfectly balanced and a good finish.*

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Castillo del Morro Tempranillo – Spain

26

*Ruby red colour with violet tints showing its youth. On the nose it is fresh and elegant with characteristic aromas of cherry and red fruits typical of this variety. Light, harmonic and round on the palate with soft tannins.*

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Don't Tell Gary, Shiraz – Australia

*A beautiful dark garnet with black cherry, blueberry and mixed spice on the nose, hints of pepper and soft oak spice.*

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Chateau Milon, Cuvee Caprice – St. Emilion, France

48

*Intense, warm, spiced fruit on the nose, a full-bodied, plush Saint-Émilion, with rich plummy fruit throughout. This is a food-friendly Bordeaux with a softly, structured finish.*

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## Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Dolce Collina Prosecco – Italy

*Aromas of golden apples, pear and honey. The well-balanced acidity provides a clean dry finish.*

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Pierre Mignon NV Champagne – France

*Attractive lemony nose with some elegance. A light, fresh lemony palate with a long finish.*

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Laurent Perrier NV Brut Champagne – France

70

*This elegant Champagne is memorable for its freshness and finesse.*

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
